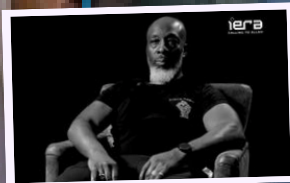

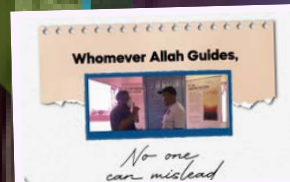

SHARING ISLAM AT MABALAQAT JAIL: A TRANSFORMATIVE EXPERIENCE

I feel truly joyful reflecting on the recent opportunity to share Islam and engage in dawah at Mabalaqat Jail.

This experience inspired me deeply, as I saw many inmates struggling with hopelessness, believing their confinement defined them and left no room for redemption. I shared with them that Allah is always ready to forgive, and that through sincere repentance and turning to Him, anyone can find forgiveness and guidance, no matter their past.

During our session with the Mabalaqat Dawah Team and the inmates, 70 out of 80 attendees embraced Islam. Their eagerness to learn, even in a limited timeframe, was profoundly moving. We assured them that we would seek permission to return regularly, providing follow-up support and a New Muslim Program to help them grow in their faith.

This was my first experience sharing Islam in such a setting, and the outcome was truly remarkable. All praise and gratitude are to Allah, Subhānahu wa Ta‘āla. We hope to expand this initiative to more jails across Pampanga and the Philippines, offering inmates hope, value, and guidance through Islam.

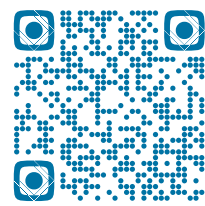
JAMAL RICHARDS' JOURNEY TO ISLAM

Jamal Richards, a devoted Muslim for over 20 years, shares a compelling story of transformation from a life of indulgence to spiritual fulfillment. Born and raised in a Christian household in a Jamaican community, Jamal describes a youth immersed in a lifestyle that included alcohol, drugs, and music, with little connection to religious practice beyond attending church.

"I wasn't forced to pray or follow strict religious routines," Jamal recalls. "It was just assumed that we were Christians. Sunday school felt like an obligation I could easily ignore." Despite this, he always remained aware of God, though in a casual, almost friendly sense, rather than a deeply reverent one.

A turning point came when Jamal observed in the Muslim community with a neighbor whose family embodied the kindness and hospitality of Islam. "There was always a welcoming atmosphere, and it felt genuine," he says. This connection, combined with guidance from his brother-in-law, gradually opened his heart to Islam.

FROM CARDIFF TO ISLAM: MY JOURNEY TO THE TRUTH

My name is Rhys, and I'm from Cardiff. I've been Muslim for about a year and a half now, but my journey didn't start anywhere near a mosque.

I grew up in Cardiff in a loving home. Like any kid, I got into things growing up, but my mum and dad did their absolute best to give us a good upbringing. They laid strong foundations in our home—values, discipline, and a sense of right and wrong. Both of my parents were heavily involved in the church, so Christianity was a big part of our lives. I took a lot from that environment, especially the sense of community and belief in God. But as I grew older, something always felt missing.

The idea that Jesus was God and the concept of the Trinity never fully made sense to me. No matter how much I tried to understand it, there was always a disconnect I couldn't ignore. I carried these questions around with me for years.

Before Islam entered my life, I was heavily influenced by Western media. Events like 9/11 left a deep impression on me, showing the first real image of Muslims. I thought Islam was aggressive and violent, and that Muslims held extremist views. Looking back now, I can see how far that was from the truth.

Islam first came into my life through a friend, someone I was with at the time. When she introduced it to me, I was skeptical, especially coming from a Christian household and knowing my parents' beliefs. Eventually, I decided to explore it further. I told myself I would see for myself.

So I bought a copy of the Qur'an and began reading. Almost immediately, things started to fall into place. The words felt true in a way I had never experienced before. The questions I had carried for so long were being answered, not just logically, but in my heart.

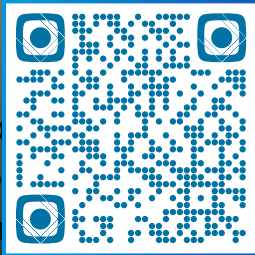
FROM CURIOSITY TO FAITH: AARON PORTSMOUTH'S JOURNEY TO ISLAM

In his teenage years, John started attending church more regularly, but he began to question the teachings, especially the concept of the Trinity. These questions led him down a path of seeking truth.

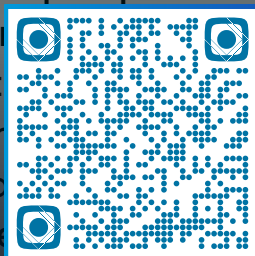
Growing up, John faced challenges and often found himself caught in a lifestyle that conflicted with the law. He had limited encounters with it were shared.

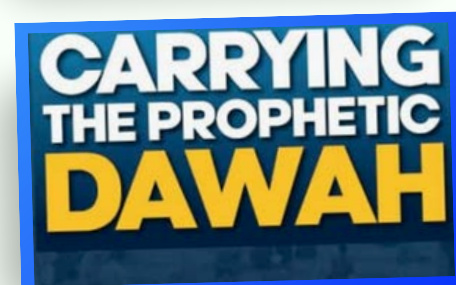

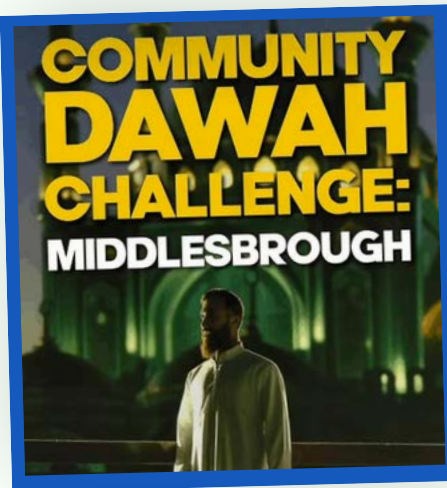

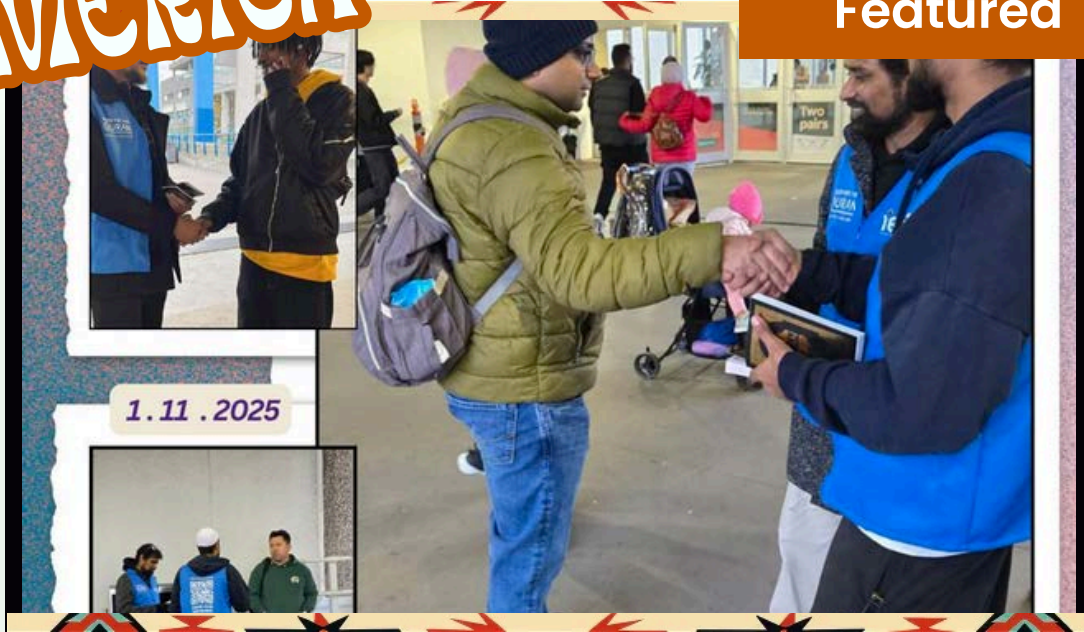
him to join the Sunday gathering. His enthusiasm were
